

Policy on Outside Clock Hours

Purpose: To establish guidelines for the calculation of minimum course-by-course outside hours.

Scope: This policy applies to all programs at California Career College.

Policy:

- 1. Certificate and Associate of Applied Science Degree Programs
 - a. Minimum course-by-course outside hours are calculated by using following formula:
 - i. Semester Credit Hours: 7.5 outside hours for each credit hour of lecture/laboratory
 - ii. Quarter Credit Hours: 5.0 outside hours for each credit hour of lecture/laboratory
- 2. Associate of Science Degree and RN to BSN Baccalaureate Degree
 - a. Minimum course-by-course outside hours are calculated by using the following formula:
 - i. For one hour of classroom or direct faculty instruction, a minimum of two hours of outside preparation.
 - ii. For one hour of laboratory work and other academic work leading to award of credit hours, a minimum of one hour of outside preparation
- 3. Activities that are acceptable for outside hours include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Nursing Care Plan creation
 - b. Reading assignments
 - c. Case Studies
 - d. Practice questions
 - e. Writing assignments (essay or research papers)
 - f. Group projects and presentations
 - g. Study guide completion
 - h. Online article reviews
 - i. Prototype models
 - j. Independent online research
 - k.

Effective Date: This policy is effective as of October 1, 2021.

Review and Revision: This policy will be reviewed annually and revised as necessary to ensure continued compliance with legal and regulatory requirements.
